I am directed to forward herewith the application
of the Secretary, Pushpagiri Residential Public School,
Cuddapah district and to state that this Government have
No Objection to accord affiliation to it subject to the
fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- 1) This State Government reserves the right to withdraw
the above Certificate at any time if the Management
fails to comply with the instructions of the State
Govt. such as illegal removal of teachers, non-payment
of salaries to the teaching staff and non-teaching staff
as per the approved scales etc;
- 2) Admissions should be made with the bonafide date of
birth Certificates;
- 3) All the untrained teachers should be replaced by
trained teachers;
- 4) To collect the tuition fee and special fee etc. as
prescribed by the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh from time
to time;
- 5) Classes and strength in the classes should be increased
as per rules in force;
- 6) The School Management should follow the rules that are
in force in the State of Andhra Pradesh;

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- 7) The District Education Officer or his nominee should
be intimated when the management makes recruitment
of candidates for various Categories of posts;
- 8) Play area and play facilities should be provided;
- 9) The Management should not collect donations either
from students or parents for admissions;
- 10) No pupil studying in the school now is put to hardship
for continuing in the same school;
- 11) The Management should implement the T.P.F. Scheme;
- 12) The Three Language Formula (3) must be compulsory
implemented particularly Telugu Language should be
taught;
- 13) Permission for Classes I to Vth should be obtained
from State Education Department.
